To re-purpose the public space around the KB Polk Recreation Center, to encourage play activities, incorporating educational and historical elements and instill 'a sense of community'.






KABOOM CHALLENGE GRANT / KB POLK RECREATION CENTER - INTRODUCTION

The Kaboom challenge grant was awarded to

The award parameters are to develop a project that:

- 1). Repurposes the Sidewalk as Art, attracting visual interest
- 2). Develop a Play Oriented Program that engages children
- 3). Develop a dialogue that is Culturally and Historically Relevant.







Kaboom Guideline:

Ensure accessibility for all ages and abilities. Make sure that the play space can accommodate walkers, wheelchairs and strollers, and that all users, regardless of age or ability have the opportunity to engage in play.






















Based on our last conversation

116' feet of sidewalk on Thedford.148' feet of sidewalk on Roper.




